## Do your part to keep our neighborhood looking GREAT

In order to keep the neighborhood looking great please do your part with the following!

- Sweep the curbs in front of your house
- ♦ Weed eat your yard and the grass/weeds that grow in the cracks of your driveway & sidewalks if you have a lawn care service, they will do this if asked
- ❖ Blow off the grass trimmings from the driveway & sidewalks
- When walking your dog PLEASE pick up after your dog
- Trim tree limbs that are hanging over the sidewalks
- Trim shrubs in your yard
- Report uneven sidewalks to Mayor's Action Line 317-327-4622 or <a href="www.indy.gov">www.indy.gov</a>
- Treat your yard for weeds
  - Fall is the best time to deal with broadleaf lawn weeds such as dandelions, clover, or thistle. Spot treat weeds leftover from the spring and summer with a post-emergent herbicide in September and October. Apply a preemergent herbicide between August and November
- Fertilize your yard
  - September and November are the two best times to fertilize a lawn in Indiana. Fall nitrogen promotes good root development, enhances storage of energy reserves, and extends color retention in cool-season lawns

According to the HLE Covenants, All garbage and trash shall be kept in containers which are not visible from the street, except on collection day.

Please put all trash in a plastic bag before putting into you trash container. This will keep loose trash from spilling out into the street. And please do not complain to Republic for your indiscretions. We have heard of other neighborhoods where Republic will not empty trash containers if trash is showing above the lid.

Please take the time and effort if you do see some trash in the streets or in your yards to pick it up and dispose of it.

# **Stop Signs and Speed Limit**
