TRAILS AND BRIDGES

Remember if you want to make architectural changes to your property (i.e. fences, decks, storage/outbuildings, swimming pools, etc) you will need to complete the Architectural Review Form and submit it to the board for approval "before" you begin the work. You also need to contact the board if you need to replace your roof or paint the trim on your home to make sure it conforms to the colors of the neighborhood.
