# Board of Directors 2020 Report and 2021 Planned Action

The board officially met 7 times to discuss and prioritize actions accomplishments for 2020 included: getting potholes filled, welcoming new neighbors, addressing snow plowing and lawn care and lake needs. The year also found a pass-lane on German Church Road, and street repair. The Pennsy Trail extension to downtown was worked on. We had a virtual Annual Meeting. Plans for 2021 include adding more street lights, fix and maintain the neighborhood trails as well as marking the entrances and making a map of the trails. There is also plans for a community clean up day, and if things go well, have a community cookout. This year the mailboxes will be replaced in either April or May.

#### **Winter Weather**

The winter weather will be here soon. Start preparing as soon as possible by getting some Ice Melt, or the like, to keep from falling and having injuries. We are obligated to keep our sidewalks free of snow for the children in the neighborhood to be able to get to their bus stops.
